Alta, UT—Why slave away in the kitchen on Thanksgiving Day? After a day on the ski slopes at Alta, relax and enjoy Thanksgiving dinner this year at the Alta Lodge and leave the cooking to Chef Paul Raddon and his staff.

The menu for the evening begins with an appetizer--insalata di mare with herb aioli, followed by butternut squash soup with sweet red pepper puree and a tossed green salad with goat cheese, toasted pecans and passion fruit vinaigrette. The main attraction--traditional roasted turkey with pan gravy—will be served with apricot and wild rice dressing, lingonberries, mashed potatoes and roasted root vegetables. Dinner is concluded with pumpkin pie.

Dinner is served from 6:15-8:30 p.m. The price is \$37 for adults, \$16 for children ages 7-12 and \$10 for ages 4-6. Reservations are recommended; call 322-4631.

The Alta Lodge opened in 1939 as Alta's first ski hotel.
